First Day of Skating Checklist:

- Registration Complete. On line registration and payment must be submitted to the club before skaters go on the ice. Unregistered skaters will not be allowed on the ice for safety & insurance reasons.
- Helmets: All skaters who have not yet completed Canskate Level 5 <u>must</u> wear a CSA approved helmet. NO BIKE HELMETS. Please check that the CSA sticker is still on your helmet and that it hasn't expired. Skaters will not be allowed on the ice without the proper equipment.
- Fundraising: This year we will <u>not</u> be requesting fundraising cheques. The club will rely on all participants doing their part to help make fundraising successful. Remember the proceeds from fundraising go directly to help offset the costs of skating and make your registration lower.
